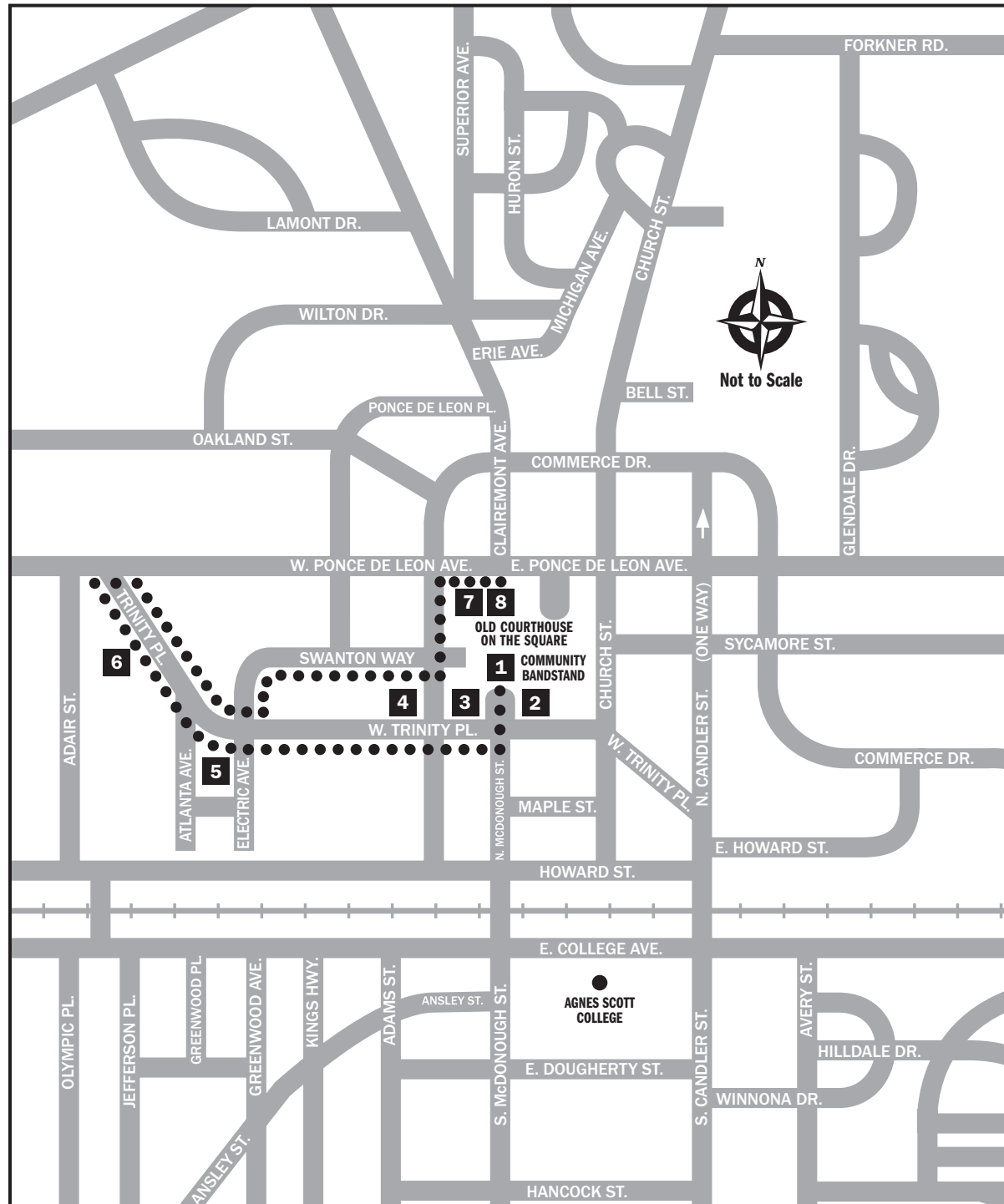

Tour Directions

Beginning at the Community Bandstand on the Square:

- Travel south on North McDonough Street.
- Right (west) at West Trinity Place.
- Follow West Trinity Place to Ponce de Leon Avenue.
- Cross West Trinity Place at Ponce de Leon Avenue, return back down West Trinity Place, traveling east.
- Go left (north) on Swanton Way and follow it to Commerce Drive.
- Turn left (north) on Commerce Drive and follow it to West Ponce de Leon Avenue.
- Turn right (east) on West Ponce de Leon Avenue and look on the right for the Old Courthouse, which is the final stop on this tour.
