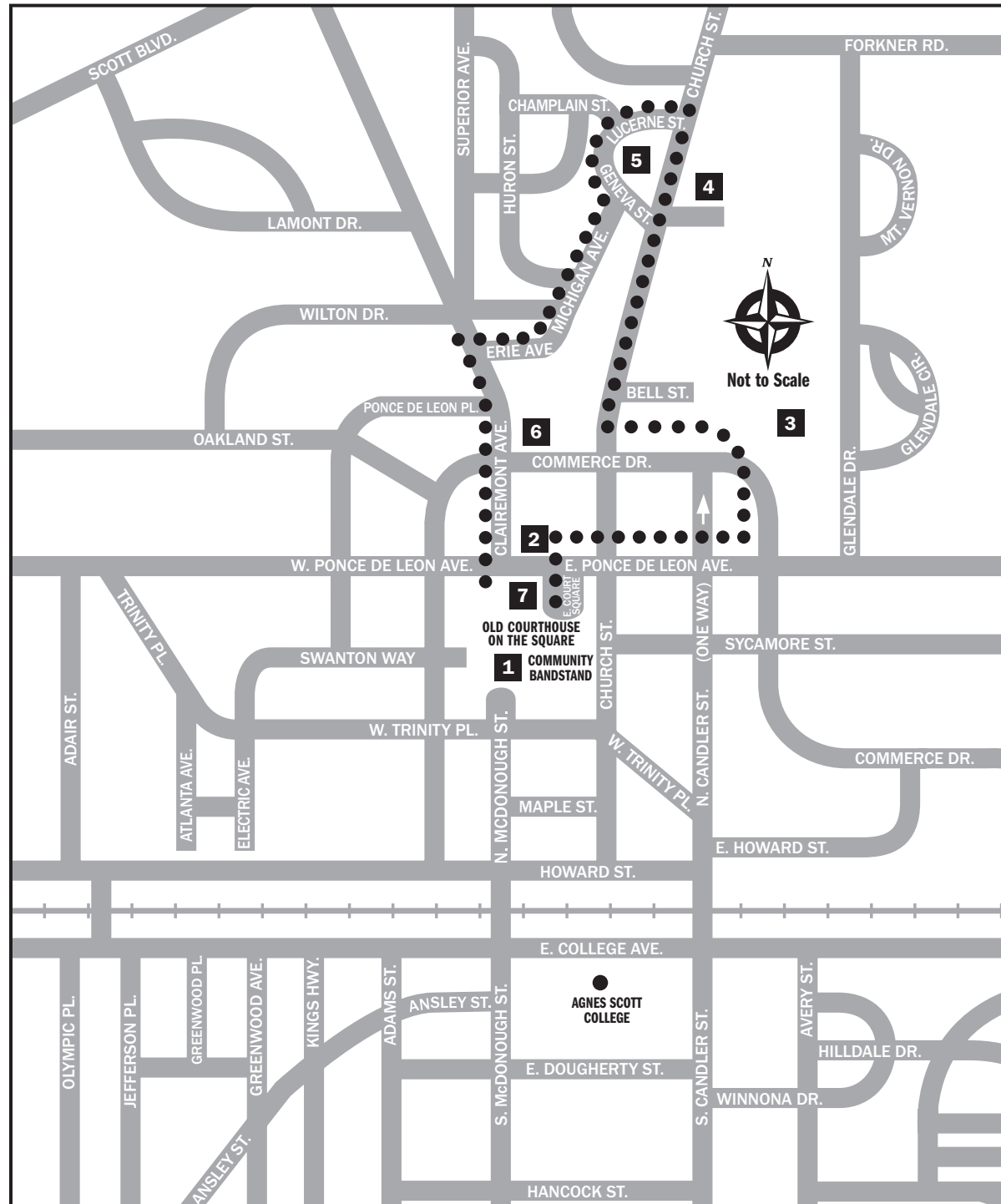


Points of Interest

- 1 Community Bandstand**
On the Square
- 2 Pythagoras Masonic Lodge**
Corner of E. Ponce de Leon and
Clairemont Avenues
*Built in 1924, designed by noted
architect William Sayward, listed in
the National Register of Historic
Places.*
- 3 Decatur Cemetery**
299 Bell St.
*Woodsy, park-like retreat. Lichen-
covered markers of early pioneer
settlers and later ornate Victorian
style markers. Oldest part of the
cemetery listed in the National
Register of Historic Places. Unique
well house was built in 1881.*
- 4 Glenlake Park and Pool**
1121 Church St.
*17-acre recreational facility features
tennis courts, basketball courts,
soccer field, playground, picnic
areas and pool.*
- 5 Great Lakes Neighborhood**
*Established in the 1920s.
Curvilinear streets named for the
great lakes of the world.*
- 6 Old Courthouse on the Square**
101 E. Court Square
*Granite walls and great columns of
the original structure built in 1898.
Now a welcome center and home of
DeKalb Historical Society.*

Tour Directions

Beginning at the Community Bandstand on the Square:

- Travel north on East Court Square.
- Right (east) at East Ponce de Leon Avenue.
- Left (north) on Commerce Drive.
- Enter Historic Decatur Cemetery at entrance on Commerce Drive.
- Cross Decatur Cemetery, exiting the west entrance on Bell Street.
- Turn right (north) on Church Street.
- Turn left (west) on Lucerne Street, follow as it curves to the left (south) and becomes Geneva Street (at Champlain Street).
- Turn right (west) on Michigan Avenue.
- Turn left (south) on Erie Avenue.
- Turn left (south) on Clairemont Avenue.
- Return to Decatur Square at Clairemont and Ponce de Leon avenues.
