

Points of Interest

1 Community Bandstand

On the Square
Site of many community events throughout the year, including the Concerts on the Square and the Blue Sky Concerts music series in May and September.

2 Clairemont Avenue

This road follows the Shallow Ford Trail, a major route used by the Cherokee Indians before and after Europeans settled in DeKalb County.

3 Great Lakes Neighborhood

Stately homes, some dating back to the late 1800s, line streets named for famous lakes.

4 Peavine Creek Watershed

Wilton Drive lies in a unique and delicate ecological area that drains into Peavine Creek, which is monitored by a local environmental group, Peavine Watershed Alliance.

5 The Sharian Carpet Building

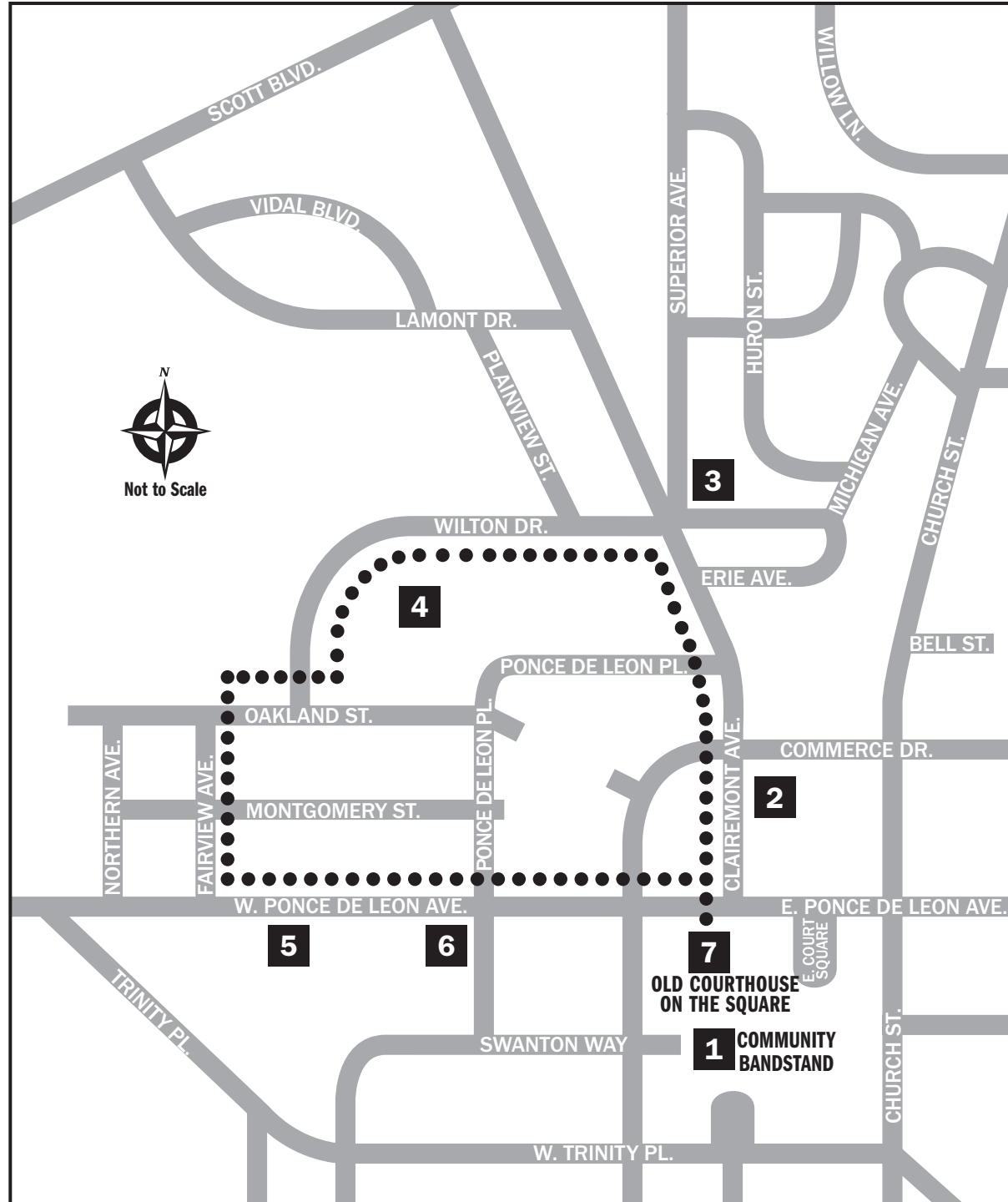
368 W. Ponce de Leon Ave.
This building is one of the few examples of Art Deco architecture in Decatur. A number of new retail shops and restaurants have opened west of this building and are worth a short side trip.

6 West Ponce Place Shops

New and recently renovated storefronts are home to a variety of shops, restaurants and services.

7 Old Courthouse on the Square

101 E. Court Square
Granite walls and great columns of the original structure built in 1898. Now a welcome center and home of the DeKalb Historical Society.

Beginning at the Community Bandstand on the Square:

- Travel north across the Square to Clairemont Avenue.
- Travel north on Clairemont Avenue to Wilton Drive.
- Turn left (southwest) on Wilton Drive.
- Turn right (west) on Oakland Street.
- Turn left (south) on Fairview Avenue.
- Turn left (east) on W. Ponce de Leon Avenue.
- Follow W. Ponce de Leon Avenue east, returning to the Old Courthouse on the Square.
