## Tour Directions

Beginning at the Community Bandstand on the Square:

- Travel south on N. McDonough Street, crossing the railroad tracks to South McDonough St.
- Turn right (west) on Oakview Road.
- Turn right (north) on Adams Street.
- Turn left (west) on Hancock Street.
- Turn right (north) on Kings Highway.
- Turn left (west) on W. College Avenue.
- Turn right (north) on Atlanta Avenue, crossing railroad tracks.
- Turn right (east) on W. Howard Street.
- Turn left (north) on Commerce Drive.
- Turn right (east) on West Ponce de Leon Avenue, returning to the Square.
