July 4th Pied Piper Parade Information

The Pied Piper Parade is designed for anyone who wishes to participate. Children and adults can ride bikes, skate, decorate wagons, et cetera and walk in the parade. In addition, neighborhoods, civic organizations, and politicians may put vehicles and/or floats in the parade.

Parade Line-up begins at 5:30pm at the First Baptist Church of Decatur located at 308 Clairemont Avenue. Walkers should line-up in the parking lot or lawn on the north side of the church. Vehicles should pull into the parking deck on the south side of the church for line up in the vehicle section.

The parade begins promptly at 6pam, winds its way to the Square for the presentation of colors and the Star Spangled Banner. The parade route is approximately one mile long. It turns right out of the church parking lot, left onto commerce Drive, right onto Church Street, right onto Ponce de Leon, left onto Commerce Drive, and left onto Trinity until it ends at N. McDonough Street.

Parade Guidelines

- ★ Do NOT throw candy (or anything else) from the car or vehicle. This presents a safety hazard.
- ★ Only one car per political candidate may enter the parade.
- ★ Loudspeakers and/or music may be used during the parade itself, but must be turned off during the parade line-up period.
- ★ Those walking should go with the group that walks. If candidates prefer to have supporters walking beside the car, please do not hand out brochures or trinkets along the way. Also be aware of the safety precautions of walking near rolling vehicles.
- ★ Parade line-up is strictly first come.
