I. Call to Order by Mayor.

Present: Mayor Garrett; Mayor pro tem Powers; and, Commissioners Dusenbury, Mayer and Walsh.

Approval of the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of May 4, 2020.

On a motion by Mayor pro tem Powers, second by Commissioner Walsh; and, all voting “aye,” the minutes of the Regular Meeting of May 4, 2020 were approved.

V. Agenda Action Items.

- A. Parkwood Neighborhood Traffic Calming Plan.
Recommend approval of the Parkwood Neighborhood Traffic Calming Plan.

On a motion by Mayor pro tem Powers, second by Commissioner Walsh; and, all voting “aye,” the proposed plan was approved including additional bicycle safety improvements as discussed.

- B. Street Milling, Pavement and Sidewalk Repairs, Traffic Calming and Striping Project Budget and Bid Award.
 - 1) Recommend establishing a project budget of \$1,884,700 for street milling, pavement and sidewalk repair, resurfacing, traffic calming and striping.

- 2) Recommend awarding a bid in the amount of \$1,748,999.03 to H.E.H. Paving, Inc. for street milling, pavement and sidewalk repair, resurfacing, traffic calming and striping.
- 3) Recommend approval of change order number 1 in the amount of -\$110,952, reducing the revised contract amount to \$1,638,047.03.

On a motion by Commissioner Walsh, second by Mayor pro tem Powers; and, all voting “aye,” the budget was established, bid was awarded, and change order number 1 were approved. Commissioner Dusenbury recused himself from the vote.

C. Adoption of Tentative 2020 Millage Rates.

1. Ordinance O-20-03 tentatively establishes the General Fund tax rate.

On a motion by Mayor pro tem Powers, second by Commissioner Dusenbury; and, all voting “aye,” Ordinance O-20-03 was adopted.

2. Ordinance O-20-04 tentatively establishes the Bond Fund tax rate.

On a motion by Commissioner Dusenbury, second by Mayor pro tem Powers; and, all voting “aye,” Ordinance O-20-04 was adopted.

3. Ordinance O-20-05 tentatively establishes the Downtown Development Authority Fund tax rate.

On a motion by Commissioner Walsh, second by Mayor pro tem Powers; and, all voting “aye,” Ordinance O-20-05 was adopted.

D. Pandemic Leave Policy.

Recommend approval of amended temporary pandemic leave policy.

On a motion by Commissioner Dusenbury, second by Mayor pro tem Powers; and, all voting “aye,” the temporary pandemic leave policy was amended as recommended.

E. Change Order-Citywide Fiber Optic Network.

Recommend approval of change order number 1 in the amount of \$56,240.

On a motion by Mayor pro tem Powers, second by Commissioner Mayer; and, all voting “aye,” change order number 1 was approved.
