**TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF DECATUR, WITHIN  
DEKALB COUNTY, GEORGIA:**

***YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED*** that on the 5th day of November 2019, a special election will be held to fill the unexpired term of At-Large Board of Education Member Annie Caiola who resigned from office effective the 1st of August 2019.

Each candidate will file notice of his or her candidacy and the appropriate affidavit in the office of the Election Superintendent at City Hall, 509 North McDonough Street, Decatur, Georgia. The opening dates for qualifying will start Monday, August 19, 2019 beginning at 8:30 A.M., and continuing until Wednesday August 21, 2019 at 4:30 P.M. The qualifying fee for Board of Education members is \$35.00.

Registration for voting in the November 5, 2019 election will cut off on Tuesday, October 7, 2019.
