

Fence Permits

Please bring in a survey or a to-scale site plan to verify the location of your property lines.

1. Are you in a local historic district? If yes, then you must have a Certificate of Exemption from Planing & Zoning. If no, then continue below.
2. Is your lot a corner lot? If yes, then you cannot install a fence more than 3 feet in height within 20 feet of the intersection. If no, then continue below.
3. The fence cannot be more than 4 feet high in the front yard. It cannot be more than 8 feet high in the side or rear yard. The side yard begins after the front building line of the house.

Any side of the fence can face your property. It can be any material (unless you are in a historic district). It has to be installed on your property (outside the right-of-way).
