We have been so happy and feel so lucky to be able for our son to go to Smarties. I've had a few friends say that their child had been on the waiting list since they were pregnant. We are writing on behalf of Smarties Academy in Decatur, in strong support of their plans for expansion.

Our son Theodore is 2 years old and has been attending Smarties since August 2022. We have had experience with three early learning centers / daycares, here in Decatur and in Boston, MA. And we can say without reservation that Smarties is second to none. But before we extol the virtues of Smarties, let us first tell you how much this community has helped our son and family.

Our son was born at the beginning of the pandemic (the very day that the city of Boston officially shut down), and he did not begin daycare / schooling until he was 1 year old. Less than a year later, we moved from Boston to Decatur for work. This was a big change for our family and for Theo in particular, and while Theo did very well in adjusting to our new home life, he struggled to adjust to his new daycare (a Montessori school). At Montessori, we went through frequent tantrums and meltdowns (very out of character for Theo) and noticed that his patience and attention span had started to suffer, not to mention his learning.

Then we learned about Smarties Academy. We were fortunate enough to have our name called from the waiting list, and within 2 weeks (just 2 weeks!) of the start of school, the tantrums were down to zero and Theo was his old self again. Within 4 weeks, Theo was potty trained and using Spanish at home. He now speaks routinely in both English and Spanish, can count to 20 and beyond, and has started to teach <u>us</u> new things. We cannot tell you what a joy it is as a parent to be in a position to learn from your child – and we never dreamed it would happen so early!

Every day when Theo wakes up, he says "I go to school today! I see Ms. Diana and Ms. Mari and Ms. Cynthia!" (these are his teachers, whom he loves). On Sundays he says, "I want to go to school tomorrow!" When we pick Theo up from school, he is happy and beaming, and he shows us his artwork and his skills on the bicycle and the song-and-dance he just learned that day. As parents, our hearts are full. To see your child be so happy every day, and to see the progress that we see in Theo, is a very special gift. And because of our experiences with other daycares, we can tell you that <u>this</u> is the magic of <u>Smarties</u>.

My daughter, Eila Patel, has been attending Smarties since June 2020. The program at Smarties is unparalleled. While visiting many local daycare facilities before her arrival, Smarties was the only one I felt comfortable leaving her with. I immediately saw that they care about each student as if they were their own. They have created safe and appropriately stimulating environments that change as the students grow. They have school wide themes that they then differentiate towards each age level for students to work on developmentally appropriate skills. They utilize a play-based curriculum, which is so crucial for children who are just learning how to be in the world, since children learn primarily through play. They believe in a reuse and recycle approach to their creating and crafting and there isn't a SmartBoard in sight, which I place an incredible value on, when thinking about developing and instructing the tiniest of minds.

However, you can read about their amazing curriculum, their approach to crafting, their limited use of technology, and while that all sets them apart, the humanness with which they approach their families and community is truly laudable. My husband and I became first-time parents during the Covid 19 Pandemic and had to make some very tough decisions about childcare; we opted to keep her home for a while but kept her spot at Smarties. Smarties is the only daycare/preschool facility I know of that decreased the tuition for families who were not attending. They have a well-known and long waitlist. But they provided this benefit for their families because they care about their families and children first. They sent out survey after survey to assess comfort levels, modified hours to make school work safely for families, and closed only when absolutely necessary, and even then offered zoom opportunities and activities to try and do at home as a way to connect with children and maintain a semblance of routine.

They LOVE celebrating birthdays- students and staff alike. Each child gets to select how they want to celebrate - Eila chose cupcakes with pink frosting and dancing. She felt so special and so celebrated. She wore her 3 year old crown proudly and told anyone who would listen what it was. The administration staff makes sure teachers also feel celebrated on their day with signs decorating the hallways, a special gift for each teacher and gentle reminders to parents if they'd like to have their child bring in a hand made card. As a former teacher, there is very little that touches a teacher's heart than personalized artwork. Smarties is more than a school, it is a place where children feel welcomed and safe and parents know their children will be well cared for.

And while the selfish part of me would love for it to stay small, I know expanding the school so more children and more families in the metro Atlanta area can benefit from this amazing program and staff is how something this great can become even greater. As I mentioned before,

finding a place to send your child to for the majority of their waking hours is an incredibly tough and sometimes painful choice. Smarties comes up all of the time as one of the most incredible daycares in this area on the mom groups I am a member of but it is always followed with, "but they have a really long waitlist so good luck getting a spot."
